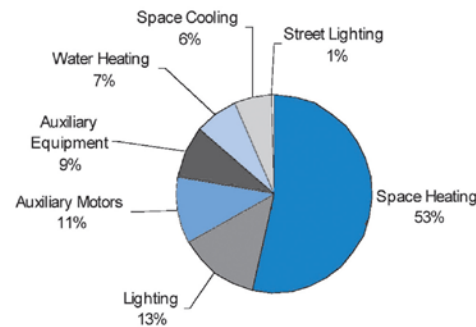


Power to You
